TEDxFukuokaWomen Hosts Event "The Space Between"

Fukuoka, Japan - November 11, 2012 - TEDxFukuoka (Joe Okubo, Organizer) will hold a "TEDxFukuokaWomen" event on Saturday, December 1st, from 12:30AM to 7:00PM at Fukuoka Women's University (Chisato Kajiyama, President).

"TEDxFukuokaWomen" is the one and only 2012 TEDxWomen type event being held in Japan. This event will be complemented by five exceptional speakers including Yukari Murakami, the Director of Asubaru, a center that promotes gender equality in Fukuoka. Approximately seventy volunteers are working to organize this event.

This year's TEDxWomen theme is, "The Space Between". As the organizers explain, "Women don't see things as just black-and-white -- we see the gray area in between. Women are curious in wanting to explore what is in between extremes, to gain the big picture and find the areas where we need more understanding and perhaps compromise. Women know that this is where life happens -- the places in between."
